Effects of Katrina

Hurricane Katrina was responsible for \$84 - \$200 billion (2006 USD).

At-least 1,836 people lost their lives (238 MS residents).

64 MS residents are still classified as missing.

Federal disaster declarations covered 90,000 square miles (an area almost the size of the UK).

Mississippi Officials calculated 90% of the structures with ½ mile of the coastline were completely destroyed.

More than ½ million Mississippians have applied for FEMA assistance (1.5 out of 6 Mississippians have applied for assistance).

As of Dec. 1, 2008: 1,783 FEMA trailers & 2,400 MEMA cottages are still be utilized by costal residents.

Camp Information

Beginning Operation: September 2005 (Just days after the storm)

CCC is operated by Lutheran Episcopal Services in Mississippi (LESM)

LESM is a joint mission venture between the Lutheran and Episcopal Dioceses of Mississippi (unique to the state of Mississippi).

Camp Coast Care has adapted to the needs of the community:

Distribution Center

Emergency Medical Center

Short-Term Recovery (Debris Removal & Clean-Up)

Implementation of Case Management (Katrina Aid Today)

Long-Term Recovery (Rehabbing & New Construction)

CCC's 3 year volunteer participation average is 2,760. That is a daily average of 53.

Over 480,000 volunteer hours have been spent on the Mississippi Gulf Coast from CCC volunteers.

CCC volunteers have rehabilitated over 391 homes (196 yearly avg.) & 22 (11 monthly avg.) new constructions.

CCC receives a weekly average of \$6,625 in room & board donations

LESM has now been able to privatize our Case Managers.

Clients meet with Case Managers to discuss and plan for short and long-term goals.

Client needs are verified via the Coordinated Assistance Network (CAN).

Case Management is current working under the MCMC grant program.

MCMC is funded by FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency)

3,754 clients were acquired under the MCMC program (this is divided amongst all CM offices).

12 active clients at one time (CCC).

Previous to the MCMC program, CM obtained more than \$1,700,000 in grant dollars (monies outside of CCC).

CCC CM is number 1 on the MS Gulf Coast for acquiring federal monies on behalf of their clients.
