Dear Steve, Dave and the Standing Committee,

The St. Luke's Vestry, in response to the two options presented to them with respect to the possible sale of the Chapel in Old Town, requests that they be given until June 1st for formulate their response.

Over the next sixty days, St. Luke's will be carefully examining and reflecting upon our mission, plans for parish growth and development, our missions and ministries, and our financial realities today and going forward. On or before June 1st, the Vestry will construct a proposal in response to those already offered to us.

I also recommend that the Diocese become actively involved in doing its own research with the governments of Summit County and Park City. Some of our members have contacted these governments and it is very unclear as to whether the Diocese will be able to sell the vacant lot at the church. It is also unclear, given all of the restrictions on the building, that the Chapel can be profitably sold. If you could do you own research in these areas, it will greatly aid our future conversations.
